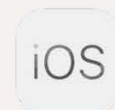

**A Note From The Pastor**



My Dear Parishioners,  
 As our nation prepares to celebrate Halloween in a modified way for another year, it is a good opportunity to remind our young people that the Christian roots of this secular holiday involve our belief that the saints in heaven are praying for us. All Saints Day, Monday Nov. 1<sup>st</sup>, is also known as All Hallows Day. The day before All Saints Day is known as All Hallows' Eve, which is where we get the word Halloween from. The day after All Saints, Nov. 2<sup>nd</sup>, is All Souls Day. It is the day that we set aside to pray for all those souls that have experienced bodily death and are not yet united with God in heaven. We pray for the healing and purification of their souls so that they will be united with God. These holy days are good reminders that our Church (the Communion of Saints) is much bigger than just the here and now.

This year, because All Saints Day is on a Monday, the obligation to attend Mass is lifted. We will still celebrate Masses for the Holy Day on Monday at 8:00 and 10:00 a.m. On Tuesday, All Souls Day, we will have Mass at 8:00 a.m. and a special 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary All Souls Mass at 7:00 p.m. At this evening Mass we will remember and pray for all those who have been buried from St. Joseph parish since its founding. We will have a memorial candle lit to symbolize our beloved dead for each of the 10 decades that our parish has existed. We will also place our All Souls envelopes and our Book of the Dead with the names of our beloved deceased in front of the statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary. As a final tribute to those that we have lost over this last year, we will read out the names of the recently deceased and place a flower in a vase in tribute to them. All are invited to attend and pray for all those who have gone before us.

### Reflect on the Readings **LOVE GOD**

As we near the end of the liturgical year we listen to Gospel readings from the final stage of Jesus' ministry—his teaching in Jerusalem. This Sunday Jesus is in conversation with one of the scribes of the temple. In a rare occurrence Jesus and the scribe agree on the two greatest commandments—to love God with all your being and to love your neighbor as yourself. In today's selection from Deuteronomy Moses gives this teaching to the Israelites as the core of their life of faith and prayer, and Psalm 18 echoes this prayer with the words, "I love you, O LORD, my strength" (Psalm 18:2). Jews and Christians agree that our greatest responsibility is to love the one and only God, and that we cannot claim to love God without loving our neighbor as ourselves. —Copyright © J. S. 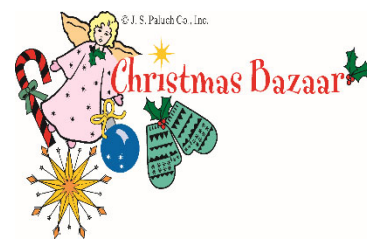

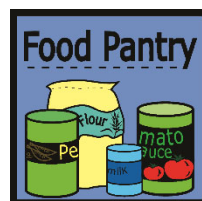

**Treasures from Our Tradition**

Every four years, we engage in one of the core activities of our democratic system: a presidential election. Actually, the institution of election can be traced to traditions in the Church, and although bishops are no longer chosen in this way, abbots and abbesses (heads of monastic communities) have almost always been elected by full voting members of their communities. The lifetime appointment begins when the monks or nuns are gathered in “chapter” at the death or resignation of the abbot, and fortunately for all involved, campaigning is not allowed! The members of the community discern, with prayer to the Holy Spirit, who among them is the best suited for leadership. Once chosen, the new leader requests the blessing of the local bishop, who usually presides at a ceremony of consecration or investiture. The ballots are always secret, and a simple majority must be achieved. In our American system the Electoral College is the determining voice in the presidential election, not the popular election on a November Tuesday, just as the monastic chapter is the electorate. Today, most religious orders elect general superiors in “chapter” by delegates of the professed members, and usually for a term of six years. A few, like the Jesuits, elect for life. At least we don’t have that weight on our shoulders when we choose a president. Four years at a time will do!

**Feast Of Faith Prayer after Communion**

The rites following the reception of Communion are very short. It is as if the Church is saying to us that the only way to respond to this great gift is to go forth and live it! But there are some significant rites yet before we are sent forth from the Mass. After Communion, we pray together in silence or sing a hymn; both are ways to thank God for the gift of the Son. Then the priest prays another collect, the Prayer after Communion. This prayer, usually very short, gathers our prayers into one. It reminds us of what we have already experienced: in receiving the Eucharist, we have received a foretaste of the heavenly banquet; we have eaten the bread of angels. This reality, this knowledge, should transform us, so that we may journey through this life with our hearts set on eternal life, and find in the Eucharist—which is food from heaven and daily bread—the strength and hope we need to work toward God’s kingdom of justice here and now. —Corinna Laughlin, Copyright © J. 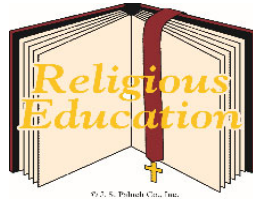

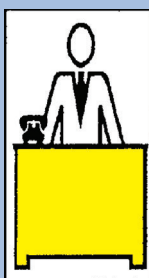
