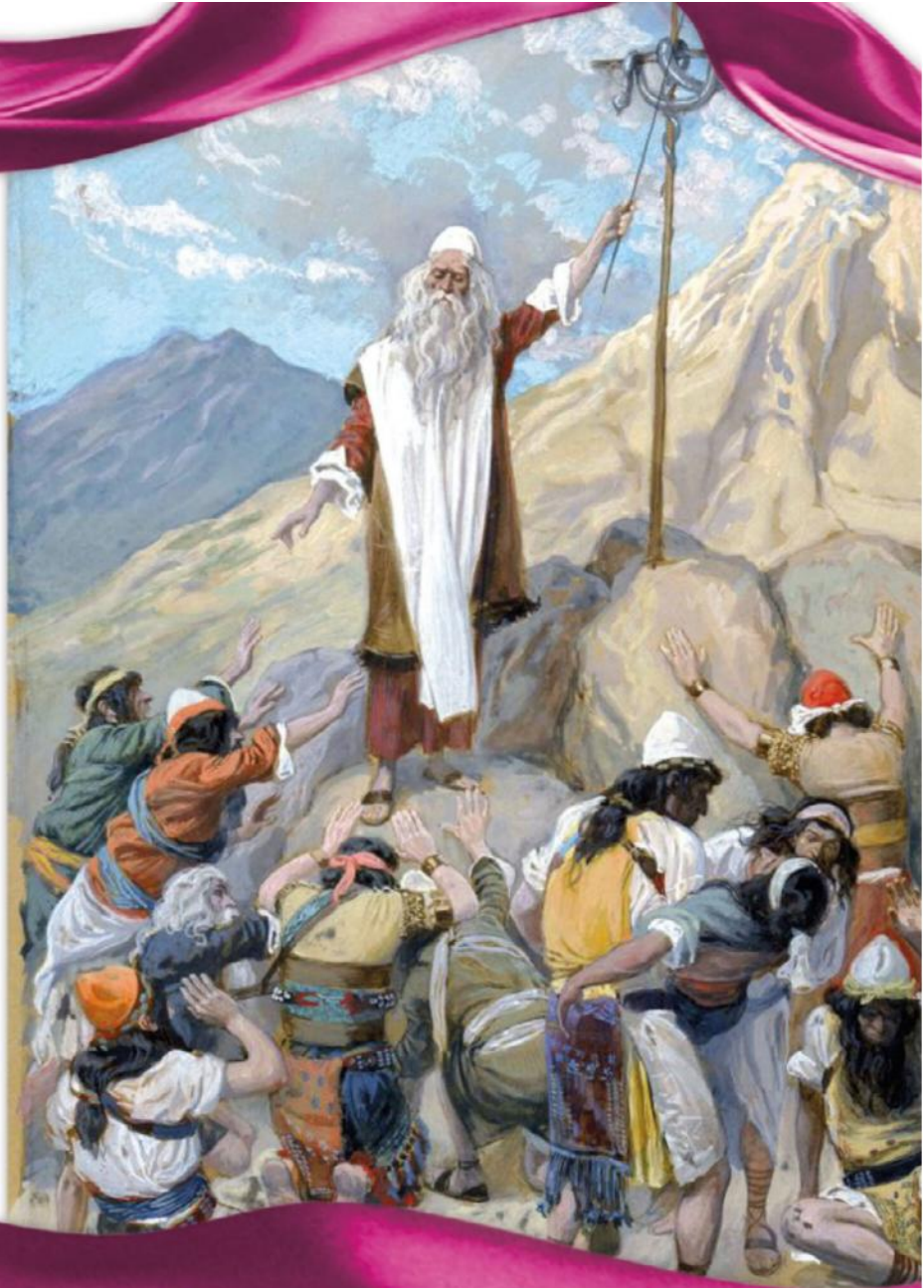

My Dear Parishioners,  
This week we welcome one of the newly ordained Auxiliary Bishops for Philadelphia, Bishop Keith Chylinski as he administers the sacrament of Confirmation to 13 of

our young people on Thursday. Please keep the young people and their families in your prayers. We pray that they will open their hearts to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit and that they will be strengthened in their faith to live out their baptismal commitment as young Catholic Christians. If you want to be specific in your prayers for them then you can pray for the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit to come to them. They are: **Wisdom** which helps us recognize the importance of others and the importance of keeping God central in our lives; **Understanding** which is the ability to comprehend the meaning of God's message; **Knowledge** is the ability to think about and explore God's revelation, and also to recognize there are mysteries of faith beyond us; **Counsel** is the ability to see the best way to follow God's plan when we have choices that relate to Him; **Fortitude** is the courage to do what one knows is right; **Piety** helps us pray to God in true devotion; and **Fear of the Lord** is the feeling of amazement before God, who is all-present, and whose friendship we do not want to lose. If you know one of these young people, please encourage them on their journey of faith.

Next week we will be celebrating our annual Triduum to St. Joseph. We invite all to join us for some special prayers to St. Joseph after the Masses on Sunday, March 17<sup>th</sup>, Monday, March 18<sup>th</sup>, and Tuesday, March 19<sup>th</sup> (the actual feast of St. Joseph). St. Joseph is our awesome patron and it is good to honor him. Here is a prayer for St. Joseph's protection that I found on the EWTN website.

Oh, St. Joseph, whose protection is so great, so prompt, so strong, before the throne of God, I place in you all my interests and desires.

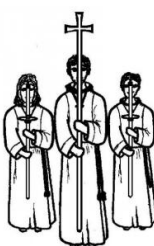

**Registration** for the 2024-2025 School Year will be held **Tuesdays: April 2, 9, 16, 23, and 30** in the CCD Office during regularly scheduled CCD classes. You must be registered in the parish before signing your child up for CCD and you must hand in a copy of your child's baptismal certificate if your child is new to the program.

I'd like to take a moment to talk about **The Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC)** program. It is designed to allow eligible businesses and individuals to use their tax dollars to support schools, such as SJR, instead of paying it to the state of Pennsylvania. Simply put, **EITC** allows you to redirect your state tax dollars to SJR to help families that value Catholic Education with tuition assistance. The program requires a minimum of only \$1,000. You are eligible if you individually or your business pays \$1,000 or more a year in income taxes to the State of Pennsylvania. In return, you receive a 90% tax credit for your 2-year commitment.

We are currently receiving EITC funds from the Foundation for Catholic Education to support students. It would be a blessing to have more funds available to help our families. The more participants in the program the more money available to us to grant scholarships to our students. If this sounds like something you'd like to learn more about, there are two more informational webinars on March 12<sup>th</sup> and March 25<sup>th</sup>. Please see the information below.
